



## Club rules for Casual Rounds

By means of the new World Handicap System entering your casual round scores to build up your playing history and handicap record is much easier and is encouraged.

Casual round scores can now **only be submitted using the MYEG app** which is available for both apple and android smart phones.

### Rules:

- You must play in an authorised format of play, such as individual stroke play, Stableford or Par/Bogey, over at least 9 or 18 holes, by the Rules of Golf, on a golf course with a current Course Rating and Slope Rating.
- You must have your score verified by someone who has witnessed the round and who is a golf club member (not i-golf) and a registered user of the MyEG app. This person will also act as your marker and sign your scorecard electronically. If the marker does not attest the score, it will not be verified and will result in a penalty score being applied by E.G.U.
- You must submit your score as soon as possible after completing your round and no later than midnight on the day of play. Your score will be sent to your marker for approval and then to your home club for processing.
- Once a score intention has been made you will be expected to return a completed electronic scorecard, failure to do so may result in a penalty score being submitted to your handicap record, which may affect your handicap index. Failure to do so repeatedly will result in your handicap being frozen.
- Retain the card for inspection if necessary – do not leave it in the card box or send a photo.
