Les Ormes Golf Club is associated to Les Ormes Resort but is run by the membership and both the Gents and Ladies have their own competition sections. To apply for Golf Club membership, you must first arrange green fee membership with Les Ormes Resort. The options you have are 5- or 7-day membership or as a pay-n-play member. This can be organised through reception at the resort, and they will explain what this fee involves.

This does not give you membership of the Golf Club.

Golf club application process:

- Complete the online application form from our website shown and fill in all the required fields; this is important as this data is eventually stored with England Golf Union (EGU) as part of the World Handicap System.
- When the club have received your application form it goes before the general committee who approve or refuse the application. Once you are accepted it implies your agree to the club constitution and rules.
- Once accepted you must pay the annual subscription fee (1st January to 31st December), at present the fees are £150 for members under the age of 65 and £100 if you are 65 and over. Discounted fees of £100 and £75 are offered for members joining after the 1st July.
- Your information will then be entered into the membership and handicap software system.

Handicaps

- On joining the Club, a new member will be required to complete a minimum of 3 x 18 holes or 6 x 9-hole scorecards (54 Holes) for the course which must be duly verified and signed by a club member. *See WHS handicapping rules on the club website.*
- If you have a CDH number already you can transfer your membership and retain your present handicap index.

Competitions

- To enter a competition, you must register with HowDidiDo a website linked to our membership and handicap system. This allows you to enter through the website, phone App or the Player Score Input (PSI) device in reception.
- The draw for competitions is done on Friday and you can remove your own name from the start sheet up to 12pm the day before the competition using HDID.
- Failing to turn up for your tee time if your name is on the HDID competition start sheet will result in disqualification from the competition (Rule 5.3a) and your name being removed from the following competition and placed on the bottom of any reserve list. (no exceptions).
