Les Ormes Golf Club is associated to Les Ormes Resort but is run by the membership and both the Gents and Ladies have their own competition sections. To apply for Golf Club membership you must first arrange green fee membership with Les Ormes Resort. The options you have are 5 or 7 day membership or as a pay-n-play member. This can be organised through reception at the resort and they will explain what this fee involves.

This does not give you membership of the Golf Club.

Golf club application process:

- Obtain an application form from our website shown below and fill in all the required fields; this is important as this data is eventually stored with England Golf Union (EGU) as part of the Central Database of Handicaps (CDH).
- When the club have received your application form it goes before the general committee who approve or refuse the application.
- Once accepted you must pay the annual subscription fee, at present the fees are £150 for members under the age of 65 and £100 if you are 65 and over.
- Your information will then be entered into the membership and handicap software system.

Handicaps

- On joining the Club, a new member will be required to complete a minimum of three scorecards (54 Holes) for the course (played from the White Competition Tees), which must be duly verified and signed by a club member, and he will then be allocated a provisional handicap not exceeding 36. A member may also be required to play a round or rounds with a member of the General Committee at their discretion, before the provisional handicap is granted. The club prefer that at least 2 cards are from our competitions.
- The provisional handicap will be reviewed in the light of subsequent play and will be confirmed when the member has satisfied the General Committee with respect to his standard of play.
- If you have a CDH number already you can transfer your membership and retain your present handicap.

Competitions

- To enter a competition you must register with HowDidiDo a website linked to our membership and handicap system. This allows you to enter through the website, phone App or the Player Score Input (PSI) device in reception.
- The draw for competitions is done on Friday and you have until Saturday evening at 9pm to add or remove your name for the list. If you are on the list after this and you miss your tee time you must pay a fine of £10 before you can enter any future competitions.
